Ovarian Stimulation

Hormonal treatment (10-12 days) will begin on the 2nd day of your period and will be monitored by ultrasound scans.

2.

Insemination

The procedure is performed 36-38 hours after the last hormone injection

3.

Donor Sperm

The donor sperm is prepared (thawed) in the lab.

4.

Fertilisation

The procedure is performed in the same clinic with the patient in the lithotomy position (typical for gynaecology exams). The selected spermatozoa are placed in the uterine cavity using a cannula. It's a painless procedure. We recommend that the patient rest for 20 minutes afterwards.

5.

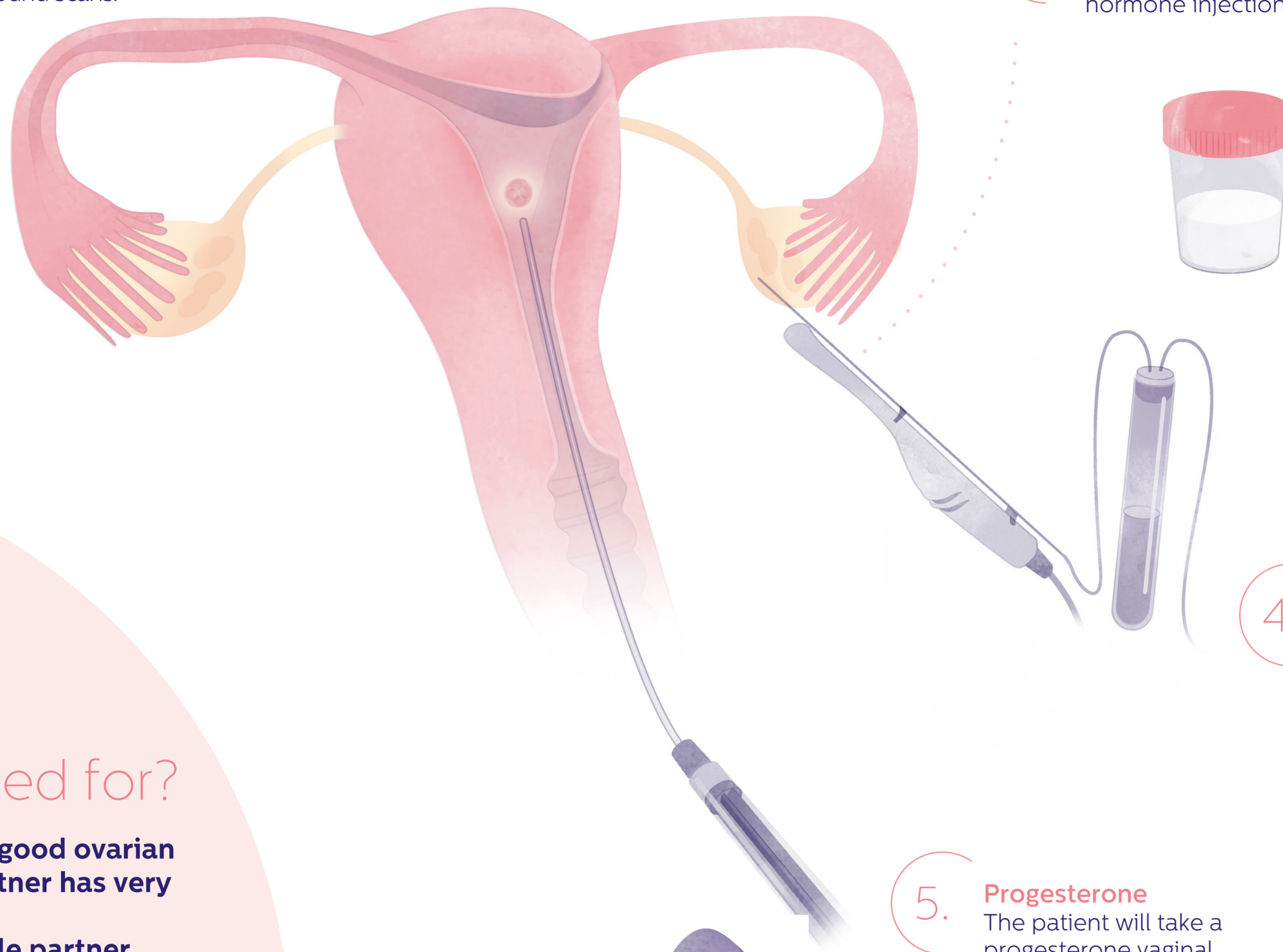
Progesterone

The patient will take a progesterone vaginal suppository every night until week 12 of the pregnancy.

6.

Pregnancy Test

14 days later you will take a pregnancy test.



Who is it recommended for?

- Young women with a good ovarian reserve and whose partner has very poor sperm quality
- Women without a male partner
- Couples where the male partner has some type of disease that he doesn't want to pass on to the embryo.
